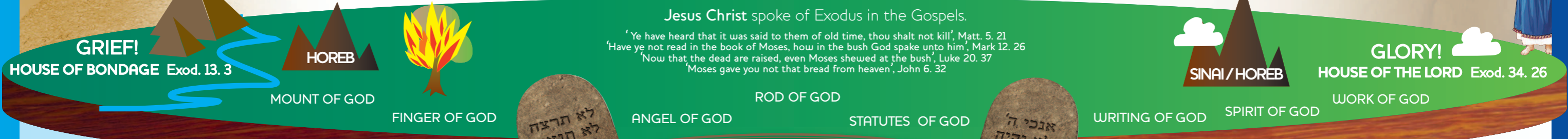
Egypt = Separation needed from the world. 2 Cor. 6. 17
